## 2016 Kingussie Golf Club - Local Rules

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS** (Rule 27)
  - a. Beyond any fence bounding the course or beyond the fences marking the new plantations at the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Holes.
  - b. Beyond the dyke to the left of the 14<sup>th</sup> Hole.
  - c. In or beyond the line of the white posts on the near bank of the River Gynack at the 16<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> Holes.
2. **WATER HAZARDS** (Rule 26) Marked by Yellow Stakes
  - a. The River Gynack is a hazard at the 7<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> Holes.
  - b. All ditches other than lateral water hazards are water hazards.
3. **LATERAL WATER HAZARDS** (Rule 26) Marked by Red Stakes
  - a. Ditches to left of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> Holes.
4. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS** (Rule 24-2)
  - a. Stones on the fairway.
  - b. A ball lying on the gravel at the Club House must be lifted
  - c. Protected trees (defined as staked, wire netted or wrapped) if they interfere with a player's stance or area of intended swing then the ball must be lifted.
  - d. All fixed sprinkler heads or hydrant covers are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. Not that intervention on the line of play is not, of itself, interference unless the player's ball lies on the putting green.
5. **PRACTICE PUTTING GREEN** (Rule 25-3)
  - a. The practice putting green is a 'wrong green'. A ball touching it must be lifted and dropped in accordance with rule 25-3.
6. **MOVEABLE OBSTRUCTIONS** (Rule 24-1)
  - a. Stones in bunkers.
7. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR** (Rule 25-1)
  - a. Areas bounded by white lines and/or appropriately marked. A player must take relief.
8. **DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES**
  - a. A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a competition, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to measure gauge or measure any other conditions that might affect his or her play (e.g gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc, the player is in breach of rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification . regardless of any such additional function is actually used
9. **FAIRWAY MARKERS INDICATE DISTANCES TO THE CENTRE OF EACH GREEN**
  - White - 200 Yards
  - Yellow - 150 Yards
  - Red - 100 Yards
